Conflict Minerals Statement

Subject: Conflict Minerals (Certain metals(tantalum, tin, tungsten, gold) sourced from DRC (Democratic Republic of the Congo) or adjoining countries (Conflict Region)).

The “Conflict Minerals Law” included as “Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wallstreet Reform and Customer Protection Act” of the United States of America, requests to identify products which contain “Conflict Minerals”.

Manufacturers have made it clear that their distributors are not authorized to provide this complex data to the end customer, as traditional component distribution activities are not within the scope of the bill’s definition of reporting requirements. However, SOS electronic realizes the importance of this initiative and fully supports its spirit.

Based on our suppliers’ information, as of this moment, this is to declare that electronic components delivered from us do not contain any substances referred to as “conflict minerals” from mines within the DRC (Democratic Republic of the Congo) and the surrounding region (Angola, Burundi, the Central African Republic, The Republic of Congo, Uganda, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Zambia).
